Supply list:

- Paper to draw on. Loose (not connected to sketchbook) pages are recommended. Regular white printer paper works for this course.
- HB pencil and a good pencil sharpener
- Optional: Mechanical Pencil with HB lead refills
- Eraser
- 18" ruler
- Geometry set
- Thin black marker pen (example: drawing pen or thin sharpie)
- Different coloured pencils or pens or thin markers
- Recommended but not mandatory:
 - T-square or set square or triangle (that is larger than what comes in your geometry set). Can make one out of cardboard if necessary
 - Large board to draw on – one you don't mind having little pin pricks placed into – such as a large paper cutting mat
 - Thumb tack
 - String
 - Tape
 - Tracing paper

For the first day you need: Pencil, pencil sharpener (or mechanical pencil), eraser, paper, and a ruler.
